





Figure 1. Temporal trend of morbidity and mortality rates, and their composition, of the eight major notifable infectious disease types in China.

SMOKING - CHINA'S MAJOR EPIDEMIC

- China = The World's Largest Consumer
- 63-73% of Mar and 1-4% of Women Smoke
- 55% of Doct
 Smoke
- By 2025 Annual "Tobacco Deaths"
 - = 3 Million
- Tobacco will kill 33% of men and 1% of women now smoking
 - = 100 million people
